Aiming Beyond Cancer (ABC)

Project aim(s)

The Aiming Beyond Cancer (ABC) scheme began in February 2017 as a joint partnership between Scottish and Southern Electric (SSE), Macmillan Cancer Support, Energy Action Scotland, and Tighean Innse Gall with funding through SSE from the Industry Initiative element of the Warm Homes Discount Scheme.

Project scope and size

The purpose of the project is to offer a layered level of support utilising a dedicated early intervention home visit service offering energy efficiency measures and support advice to identified priority households in the Western Isles with a diagnosed cancer sufferer. ABC is a reactive and responsive project, intended specifically to meet the needs of the particular client group. In all instances, the client's needs take precedence over process.

Staff involvement

TIG manage local delivery of ABC having the appropriate industry accreditations, memberships, qualifications, and standards required for measures installation including Achilles B2, PAS2030, ISO 14001, 18001 and 45001 as well as the appropriate insurances.

Delivery is achieved through a network of local approved contractors with accreditations for Gas Safe, Oftec, EIC and similar, capable of delivering measures throughout the island communities targeted.
