Edge of Scotland

## Project aim(s)

The project aimed to encourage the uptake of energy efficiency measures within the self-funded sector in the Western Isles and to provide a hand holding service to facilitate this. Included was the liaison and interaction with over 600 homes and 200 businesses. The project also focussed on encouraging behaviour change and included advice around energy efficiency for their properties and the best ways to programme heating systems. We also delivered tailored energy advice to every household visited, regardless of measures installed.

## Project scope and size

The project ran for 18 months during which time there was interaction with over 800 individual households and business across the Outer Hebrides. The project was evaluated by the energy department of the University of the Highlands & Islands.

## Staff involvement

The project was delivered by project officer Adam Keltie and was managed by Dan Morrison, Energy Services Director.
