Warm and Well Western Isles

Project aim(s)

The project aims to reduce the high level of fuel poverty in the Western Isles by targeting key client groups with advice and support and ensuring that the installation of energy efficiency measures and heating systems are considered.

Project scope and size

The project delivers the fuel poverty aspect of the Western Isles Poverty and Social Inclusion Challenge Fund project for Comhairle nan Eilean Siar (CnES). The phase 2 project delivers in-depth energy advice and support to households in need across the fragile communities of the Outer Hebrides.

We will identify those most in need and particularly those vulnerable people affected most by living in cold, damp homes. Having identified households in need we will then visit them in the home and establish their energy requirements, detail a plan of action (including liaison with other relevant local partners) and agree the mechanism to best help them.

The project is being delivered by the team of fuel poverty officers; Adam Keltie, Kirsty MacLeod and Martha MacLeod along with and managed by Dan Morrison, Energy Services Director.
