SSE Energy Outreach

Project aim(s)

The aim of the project was to carry out 200 home energy visits, giving householders much needed advice on how to save on their fuel bills. Online and telephone advice was also offered and new enquiries promoted by carrying out over 40 events. The project also aimed to teach children about energy, renewable technologies and the effects and what changes we can do around climate issues.

Project scope and size

This was a two year project working throughout the Western Isles. In partnership with one of the big six energy suppliers, Tighean Innse Gall helped Western Isles residents with their energy and fuel poverty issues. The project also installed over 1,000 LED light bulbs. The project ran from April 2015 – March 2017.
